Day 1 Home City to Fort Lauderdale, FL

Visit the **Key West Aquarium**, home to sharks, turtles, stingrays, tropical and other various fish found in the beautiful waters of Key West. Tour Florida's only presidential site, **The Harry S. Truman Little White House**, which was originally constructed in 1890 as naval officers housing.

Day 4 Key West

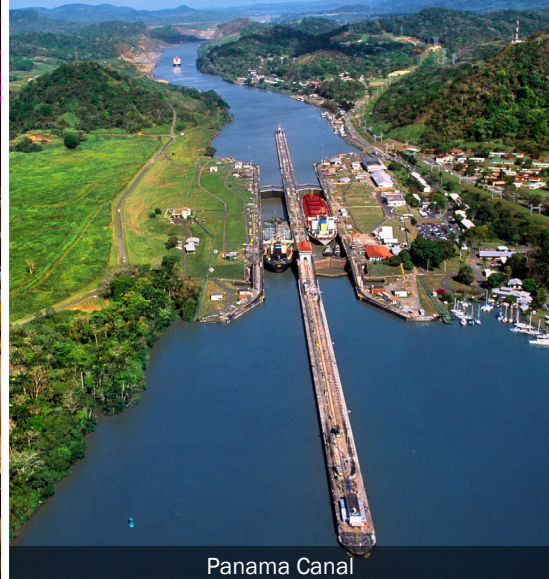

Day 5 Key West to Miami

Day 16 Manzanillo, Mexico

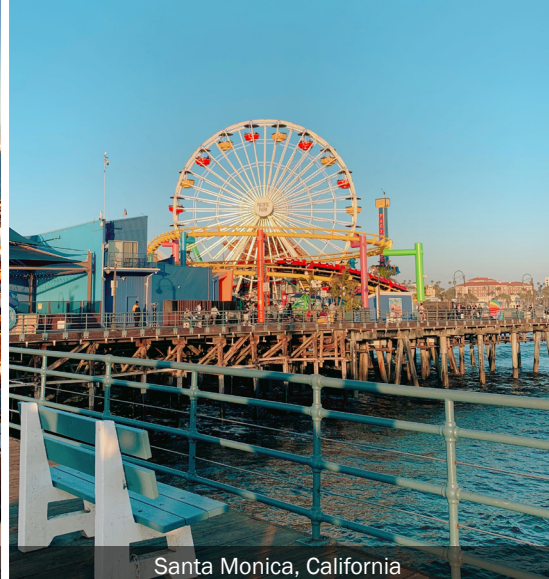
A picturesque fishing port-turned-tourist resort and self proclaimed sail fish capital of the world, Manzanillo is the ideal place for water sports and shopping!

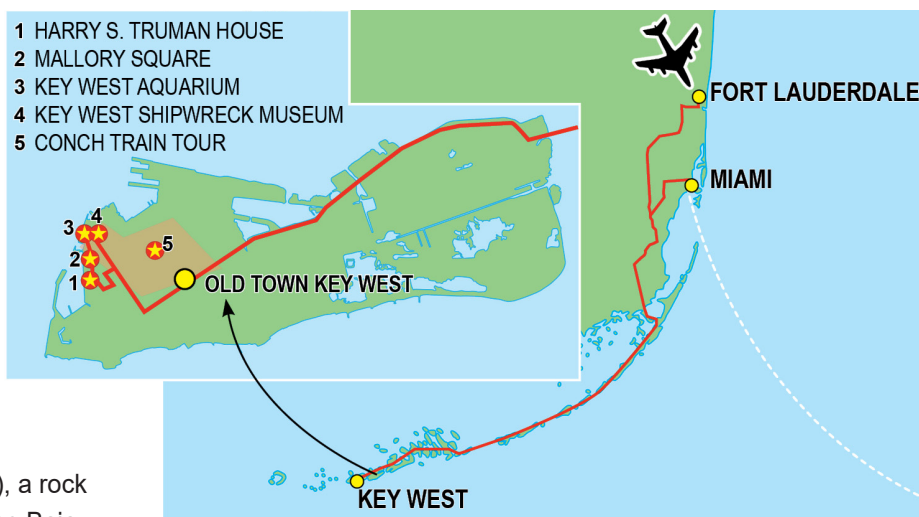
Day 22 Santa Monica to Home City
