Day 1 Home City to Calgary, AB

Take the WestWorld Coach from Regina to Saskatoon (and along route) to Calgary.

Day 2 Home City to Revelstoke, BC

Your first stop today will be at **Banff National Park**. You will have some time to explore the shops and have a cup of coffee. You will enter BC and cross through the **Rogers Pass** and on to Revelstoke, our home for the night.

Day 3 Revelstoke to Victoria, BC

Today you head for the coast. You will stop in Hope for an **included lunch**, and depending on the schedule, there may be some time to browse the shops and have a coffee at the **Tsawwassen Ferry Terminal**. Keep your eyes open for whales and other sea life as you sail through the Gulf Islands and on to your home away from home, Victoria, for the next seven nights.

Day 4 Victoria

You will have a free morning to get acquainted with your home, the Royal Scot Hotel & Suites. There should also be some time to head over to the grocery store to stock your kitchenette for the week. There are many interesting sights within a short walk of the hotel. This afternoon, we will have a **City Tour**, including the scenic **Marine Drive**. We may even get to do some beach combing!

Day 5 Victoria

Heading up island today, the first stop will be the **Malahat Skywalk** offering awe inspiring views of sea inlets and mountains. Then it's off to **Cathedral Grove**, the magnificent temperate rainforest boasting enormous 800-year-old trees surrounded by a carpet of ferns and draping moss.

Day 7 Victoria

Enjoy a free day to explore downtown Victoria.

Board the coach and head to **Butchart Gardens**. For over 90 years, this amazing 50-acre garden has been a symbol of Victoria's beauty. You will also stop at the **Butterfly Gardens** today.

Day 9 Victoria

Your last day in Victoria is a free day.

Day 10 - Victoria to Kelowna

One last **ferry crossing**. You will stop again in Hope for an **included lunch**. Arriving in Kelowna, you will get to enjoy a free evening.

Day 11 - Kelowna

A leisurely free morning to stroll along the **Okanagan Lake**. This afternoon we will have a **wine tasting** at one of the many vineyards surrounding Kelowna. Tonight, join your fellow travellers, bus driver and tour director for your **Farewell Dinner**.

Day 12 - Kelowna to Calgary, AB

Today your first stop will be in Revelstoke, then on to Golden for a lunch break. Calgary passengers bid us farewell while the rest of the passengers overnight.
