### Day 1 Home City to Halifax, NS

Fly from home to Halifax and transfer to hotel. (Airfare not included in tour)

### Day 2 Halifax

Visit the UNESCO World Heritage Site, **Lunenburg**. Starting with a guided walking tour of Lunenburg, then free time to explore the **Fisheries of the Atlantic Museum** on your own.

### Day 3 Halifax

This morning's **city tour** of historic Halifax includes a visit to the passenger gravesites of the ill-fated Titanic. After lunch, visit the **Maritime Museum** and then on to the most photographed village in Canada, **Peggy's Cove**. **Dinner is included** this evening.

### Day 4 Halifax to Sydney

Enroute to Sydney, travel through the rolling hills, fertile valleys, forests, rivers, and lakes of Nova Scotia, heading north to scenic Cape Breton Island.

### Day 5 Sydney to Fortress of Louisbourg and Return

A historic day trip to the **Fortress of Louisbourg National Historic Site**. Where French soldiers march down the streets of town as ladies dance in formal parlours. Cannon fire shakes the ground as harpsichord tunes mingle with baked bread aroma drifting from the stone bakery. Step through Louisbourg's fortress walls and time-warp back to the 1700's. Chat with fishermen, sailors, and servants. Watch lacemaking as stew simmers on an open-hearth fire. It's so real, it seems surreal. Then visit **Cape Breton's Miners Museum**. Browse the modern exhibits paying tribute to the region's long and rich history of coal mining. The museum is also home to the famous choir of miners 'The Men of the Deeps'. During your free time, perhaps enjoy a stroll through the historic village or opt to join a retired miner guide for an underground experience.

### Day 6 Cabot Trail

Today, travel the breathtaking **Cabot Trail**, the most photographed and scenic highway in Canada. There will be plenty of photo stops along the way. Stop to visit the **Alexander Graham Bell National**



**Historic Site.** It's not your traditional museum, with manicured landscapes, vibrant gardens, and panoramic views of Baddeck Bay.

**Day 7 Sydney to Charlottetown, PEI**

Take a ferry across the **Northumberland Strait** to PEI and then onto Charlottetown, your home for the next two nights.

**Day 8 Charlottetown**

A local guide will spend the day touring you around Prince Edward Island, including a **city tour** of vibrant **Charlottetown**. Of course, no tour of PEI would be complete without a visit to the **Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place**. For dinner tonight, enjoy a traditional **PEI Lobster Dinner** (if you are not a seafood lover, alternatives are available).

**Day 9 Charlottetown to Saint John, NB**

Travelling to New Brunswick today, you drive across the 13-km long **Confederation Bridge**. Stopping at **Hopewell Rocks**, where the highest tides in the world occur, twice a day! Then you experience rolling uphill at **Magnetic Hill** in Moncton, before heading to Saint John, home for the next three nights.

**Day 10 Saint John to St. Andrews By-The-Sea and Return**

Depart for **St. Andrews By-The-Sea**. St. Andrews is a treasure trove of beautiful architecture, unparalleled scenery, and rich marine life. While here, enjoy a spectacular **Whale Watching** tour on the Jolly Breeze Tall Ship. Visit **Ministers Island** by driving across the sea floor at low tide and enjoy a **guided tour of the Van Horne Estate** while on the island.

**Day 11 Saint John**

Enjoy a **city tour** of Saint John this morning, then visit the **Reversing Falls**. If the timing is right, you can witness this unique phenomenon created by the collision of the Bay of Fundy and the Saint John River. As the Bay's tides rise, they gradually reverse the flow of the river. This evening join your new friends, tour director and bus driver for a **WestWorld Tours Farewell Dinner**.

**Day 12 Saint John to Home City**

Transfer to the airport for your flight home.
