DAY 1 – Arrival in Halifax, NS

Your journey begins with a flight from your home city to Halifax, the vibrant capital of Nova Scotia. Upon arrival, make your way independently to the hotel. Settle in and enjoy your first evening at leisure, perhaps taking a stroll along the historic waterfront or enjoying a local seafood dish at one of Halifax's charming restaurants.

DAY 2 – Exploring Lunenburg

Today, venture out to the picturesque town of **Lunenburg, a UNESCO World Heritage Site** known for its colorful buildings and maritime heritage. Begin with a guided walking tour through the town's historic streets, where you'll learn about its unique architecture and seafaring past. Afterwards, enjoy free time to explore the **Fisheries Museum of the Atlantic**, where exhibits and interactive displays bring the region's fishing legacy to life.

Day 3 – Halifax History & Coastal Beauty

Start the day with a **guided city tour of Halifax**, rich in history and culture. A highlight of the morning is a visit to **Fairview Lawn Cemetery**, the final resting place of many Titanic passengers. In the afternoon, delve deeper into maritime history at the **Maritime Museum of the Atlantic**. Later, travel to **Peggy's Cove**, a quaint fishing village perched on rugged granite shores, famous for its iconic lighthouse and breathtaking coastal views.

Day 4 – Scenic Drive to Sydney

Leave Halifax behind and journey north through Nova Scotia's rolling hills, fertile valleys, and tranquil lakes. As you cross into **Cape Breton Island**, the landscape transforms into a tapestry of forested highlands and winding rivers. Arrive in Sydney, your gateway to Cape Breton's rich history and natural beauty.

Day 5 - Fortress of Louisbourg and Cape Breton Miners Museum

Step back in time with a full-day excursion to the **Fortress of Louisbourg National Historic Site**. Experience life in the 1700s as costumed interpreters reenact daily life in this reconstructed French colonial town. Watch cannon fire, listen to harpsichord music, and smell fresh bread baking in stone ovens. Later, visit the **Cape Breton Miners Museum**, where you'll discover the region's coal mining heritage through engaging exhibits. You'll also have the option to join a retired miner for an unforgettable underground tour.

Day 6 – The Cabot Trail Adventure

Today's journey takes you along the legendary **Cabot Trail**, one of Canada's most scenic drives. With dramatic coastal cliffs, lush forests, and panoramic ocean views, photo opportunities abound. Along the way, visit the **Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site** in Baddeck, where beautifully landscaped grounds and interactive exhibits celebrate the life and inventions of the famous scientist.

Day 7 – Ferry to Prince Edward Island

Depart Cape Breton and board a ferry across the Northumberland Strait to Caribou, Nova Scotia. Continue your journey to Charlottetown, the charming capital of Prince Edward Island. Enjoy the scenic drive and settle into your accommodations for a two-night stay.

Day 8 – Discovering PEI

A local guide will lead you through the highlights of Prince Edward Island, including a tour of Charlottetown, the birthplace of Canadian Confederation. Visit the beloved **Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place**, where the literary world of Lucy Maud Montgomery comes to life. In the evening, gather in New Glasgow for a traditional **PEI Lobster Dinner**, with alternative options available for non-seafood lovers.

Day 9 – Journey to Saint John, NB

Cross the impressive 13-kilometre **Confederation Bridge** into New Brunswick. Stop at **Hopewell Rocks** on the **Bay of Fundy**, famous for its towering flowerpot formations

and the world's highest tides. Continue to Magnetic Hill in Moncton, where vehicles appear to roll uphill—a curious natural illusion. Arrive in Saint John, your home for the next three nights.

Day 10 - St. Andrews By-The-Sea Excursion

Travel to the charming seaside town of **St. Andrews By-The-Sea**, known for its historic architecture and marine wildlife. Embark on a **whale watching** adventure aboard the **Jolly Breeze Tall Ship**, where you may spot humpbacks, minke, and dolphins. Later, drive across the ocean floor at low tide to **Ministers Island** and tour the Van Horne Estate, a grand mansion with sweeping views and fascinating history.

Day 11 – Saint John

Enjoy a morning **city tour of Saint John**, followed by a visit to the **Reversing Falls**, a natural phenomenon where the powerful tides of the Bay of Fundy reverse the flow of the Saint John River. In the evening, gather with your fellow travellers, Tour Director, and Bus Driver for a memorable WestWorld Tours **Farewell Dinner** to celebrate your journey.
