Churchill, Manitoba is one of the most alluring destinations in North America. Known for its spectacular scenery, wondrous wildlife, seductive spirit; a one-of-a-kind northern town like no other. Lying on the edge of the arctic, venture out in a rover over the tundra and taiga learning about the unique landscape of the area and make sure to always be on the lookout for wildlife such as caribou, eagles, and if you're lucky, a polar bear! Known as the Polar Bear and Beluga Whale capital of the world, during the summer months you will see Belugas by the hundreds in the Churchill River estuary on a whale watching tour followed by a tour of Fort Prince of Wales. Enjoy a lovely town & area tour, visit Cape Merry National Historic Site, the Itsanitaq Museum and enjoy some free time to wander around this special northern town!

Itinerary

Beluga Whales in the Churchill Estuary

DAY 1: Home City to The Pas, MB

Starting out in Moose Jaw/Regina, the coach will travel to Saskatoon/ Yorkton with pickups en route. Our journey will then continue to The Pas, our first overnight stop, often referred to as the Gateway to the North.

DAY 2: The Pas to Thompson

Make a refreshing stop at Pisew Falls Provincial Park to stretch our legs and marvel at the breathtaking falls. Afterward, head to Thompson, where you'll have some free time to shop before boarding the Via Rail Train for our overnight journey to Churchill.

**Via Rail seating is in Economy Class.*

**Sleeper Plus Class may be available for an upgrade, subject to availability and limited in number.*

**Please note that food options are limited on the Thompson-Churchill route, so we recommend coming prepared.*

DAY 3: Via Rail to Churchill

Arriving in Churchill in the morning, meet our local guide for an orientation tour of the town. After the tour, have some free time to enjoy lunch and check into your hotel. In the afternoon, embark on a boat tour for beluga whale watching, followed by a visit to the Prince of Wales Fort National Historic Site for a tour of the grounds. In the evening, join your fellow travellers for a welcome dinner at the hotel.

**Please note that the itinerary for Days 3, 4, and 5 is subject to change based on local schedules, tides, weather conditions, and any logistical challenges associated with travelling in northern and remote areas.*

DAY 4: Churchill

This morning, we set out for a comprehensive tour of the area, including stops at notable sites such as Cape Merry National Historic Site, the Coast Road, "Miss Piggy," and the Polar Bear Holding Facility, among others. In the afternoon, visit the Itsanitaq Museum and explore the Port of Churchill. Later, enjoy an engaging talk with a Parks Canada Speaker, who will provide insights into the region's history and its significance.

DAY 5: Churchill to Via Rail

After checking out of the hotel, embark on a Polar Rover Tour across the tundra. Keep an eye out for caribou, eagles, and other wildlife, including the elusive polar bear (with a 25% chance of sighting during the summer). You will also get to view the Churchill Northern Studies Centre, the Rocket Range and its launch site, and capture a photo of the Ithaka Shipwreck. The afternoon is yours to explore the town at your leisure, visit the local shops, or stop by the Parks Canada Interpretive Centre, located in the train station. Later, board the Via Rail Train for your overnight journey back to Thompson.

DAY 6: Via Rail to Thompson and then The Pas

This morning our train arrives in Thompson where our coach has been patiently waiting for us. We return to The Pas for our last night.

DAY 7: The Pas to Home City

Lots of time today to reminisce with everyone about our Churchill adventure before arriving back home.

Sleeper Plus Accommodations on VIA Rail

Experience comfort and privacy while traveling overnight with VIA Rail's sleeper options. Please note: sleeper accommodations must be booked before December 31st, as berths and cabins sell out quickly. **We have limited availability—please call us for more information and to check availability.**

*** Accessibility: Upper berths require the use of a ladder with 4 steps and may not be suitable for persons with reduced mobility.*

Berths

- Daytime: Wide couch-style seat facing another berth seat.
- Nighttime: Folds out into a bed with heavy curtains for privacy.
- Note: You may be seated with someone you don't know.

Cabin for 1

- Daytime: Comfortable sofa chair.
- Nighttime: Lower bed pulls out from the wall; upper bed folds down.
- Features: Window with blind.

Cabin for 2

- Daytime: Two comfortable sofa chairs.
- Nighttime: Chairs are replaced by an upper and lower bed.
- Features: Private washroom, large window with blind.

Cabin for 3

- Daytime: One sofa and two chairs.
- Nighttime: Three beds—one upper and two lower.
- Features: Private washroom, large window with blind.
