Mt. Denali

What's Included

19 Nights Accommodation

DAY 1: Regina to Edmonton, SK

Departing from Regina, we head north, meeting fellow travellers in Saskatoon before arriving in Edmonton to greet our fly-in guests for the evening.

Day 2 - Edmonton to Fort St. John, BC

Dawson Creek marks the start of the legendary Alaska Highway at Mile 0. We'll stop for a photo and receive a warm welcome and Mile 0 Pin from the Visitor Centre. The day ends with a welcome reception at our hotel.

Day 3 – Fort St. John to Fort Nelson

Leaving Fort St. John, the northern adventure begins in earnest. In Fort Nelson, we'll visit the Heritage Museum and the Visitor Centre.

Day 4 – Fort Nelson to Watson Lake, YK

Stunning scenery awaits, with chances to spot black bears, bison, and stone sheep. We'll stop at Laird Hot Springs for a relaxing dip and picnic lunch. Later, we visit the Signpost Forest –bring a sign to add your mark!

Day 5 – Watson Lake to Whitehorse

As you journey towards Whitehorse, the enchanting vistas of northern Canada will continue to unveil themselves. Upon arrival, you'll be treated to the picturesque beauty of Miles Canyon. We've also planned for a visit to the S.S. Klondike Historical Site, where you'll partake in a guided tour of the grounds and have the opportunity to watch a captivating film about one of Canada's rare surviving steam-powered paddle wheelers.

Day 6 - Whitehorse to Skagway, AK and return

Today, we embark on an unforgettable adventure aboard the White Pass & Yukon Railroad. Starting in Fraser, BC, you'll traverse 27.7 miles of awe-inspiring mountain passes, picturesque bridges, and fascinating tunnels, all while enjoying a fully narrated train ride. Enjoy free time in this historic gold rush town before returning to Whitehorse.

Day 7 – Whitehorse to Dawson City

We venture deeper into the pristine Yukon wilderness, stopping for a picnic lunch en route to Dawson City. Here, history comes alive amidst gravel roads and wooden sidewalks, offering a vivid glimpse into the Gold Rush era. Tonight, enjoy the show at Diamond Tooth Gerties, where a troupe of skilled singers and dancers, accompanied by live musicians, will mesmerize you with a traditional Cancan show. After, join us for a champagne toast atop the Midnight Dome, offering breathtaking views overlooking Dawson City.

Day 8 – Dawson City

Start with a visit to the Dawson City Museum, followed by a guided city tour and a stop at Dredge #4 Historical Site for a unique look into gold mining history.

Day 9 – Dawson City to Fairbanks, AK

We travel the scenic 'Top of the World' highway into Alaska, stopping at the 'Welcome to Alaska' sign and Delta Junction Visitor Centre to collect our Alaska Highway Certificates. We end the day in Fairbanks.

Day 10 – Fairbanks

Embark on a City Tour of Fairbanks, getting acquainted with its unique charms. We stop at the Santa Claus House, adding a touch of holiday magic to our journey. Enjoy a hearty lunch at the Riverboat Discovery Dining Hall, followed by a sail on the Riverboat Discovery along Alaska's waterways, witness bush planes taking off

alongside the boat, visit champion sled dogs, and immerse yourself in Athabascan culture at the Chena Indian Village. In the evening, enjoy an Alaskan Salmon Bake and the 'Golden Heart Revue' at the Palace Theatre.

Day 11 – Fairbanks to Anchorage

As we bid farewell to Fairbanks, our journey leads us southward to Anchorage. En route, we'll follow the scenic Parks Highway, which grants us spectacular vistas of Denali Park and the majestic mountain itself. Along this picturesque route, we'll make a well-deserved stop at Denali Viewpoint South, providing the perfect opportunity to capture memorable photos and stretch our legs. Our adventure continues as we reach Anchorage, where we'll settle in for the next two nights.

Day 12 – Anchorage

Our morning kicks off with a captivating City Tour of Anchorage, the largest city in Alaska. This tour promises a wealth of intriguing stops, and one highlight is a visit to 'Alaska Wild Berry Products', where you can marvel at the world's largest chocolate waterfall! The afternoon is yours to enjoy at your own pace. You can opt to relax and explore Anchorage independently, taking in its unique charms, or take some time to prepare for the exciting week-long cruise adventure that lies ahead.
