Day 1 - Home City to Halifax, NS

Your Maritime adventure begins! Fly from your home city to Halifax, where ocean air and East Coast hospitality welcome you. Make your own way to the hotel, settle in and get ready for the memorable journey ahead.

Day 2 - Halifax

Step into postcard-perfect **Lunenburg**, a colourful seaside community and **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. A **guided walking tour** introduces its rich seafaring story, distinctive architecture and charming waterfront. Afterwards, enjoy time to explore at your own pace, including the **Fisheries Museum of the Atlantic** on Lunenburg's historic waterfront.

Day 3 - Halifax

Today a **historic City Tour** of Halifax includes a visit to **Fairview Lawn Cemetery** where there are gravesites of some of the passengers on the ill-fated Titanic. In the afternoon, the **Maritime Museum of the Atlantic** is on the agenda and then out to the most photographed village in Canada, **Peggy's Cove**.

Day 4 - Halifax to Sydney

Leave Halifax behind and journey through Nova Scotia's rolling hills, fertile valleys, forests, rivers and lakes. As the scenery unfolds, travel north toward beautiful Cape Breton Island and the harbour city of Sydney, your base for the next chapter of the tour.

Day 5 - Day trip to Fort Louisbourg

Travel back to the 1700s at the remarkable **Fortress of Louisbourg National Historic Site**. Inside the fortress walls, costumed interpreters, cannon fire, period music and the aroma of bread from the stone bakery bring history vividly to life. Meet the fishermen, soldiers, sailors and servants who recreate daily life in this once-bustling fortified town. Later, visit the **Cape Breton Miners Museum** to discover the region's proud

coal-mining heritage, view exhibits connected to the famous Men of the Deeps and, during free time, perhaps join a retired miner guide for an optional underground experience.

Day 6 - The Cabot Trail

Get your camera ready for one of Canada's most celebrated drives. Travel the breathtaking **Cabot Trail** as it winds through dramatic highlands and along the coast, with plenty of stops to admire and photograph the views. Continue to the **Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site** in Baddeck, where fascinating exhibits are complemented by manicured grounds, colourful gardens and panoramic views over Baddeck Bay.

Day 7 - Sydney to Charlottetown, PEI

Today, the journey continues across the water. Board the **ferry** at Caribou, Nova Scotia, and cross the Northumberland Strait to Wood Islands, Prince Edward Island. From there, it is a short drive to charming Charlottetown, your home for three nights and the perfect base for exploring Canada's smallest province.

Day 8 - Prince Edward Island

Dig into one of Prince Edward Island's best-known traditions with a visit to a working **potato farm**. Meet the farmer and learn how the Island's famous crop is grown from field to harvest. Continue to the **Canadian Potato Museum & Antique Farm Machinery Museum** for an entertaining look at the mighty potato and PEI's agricultural heritage. A surprise stop adds one more memorable moment before returning to Charlottetown.

Day 9 - Charlottetown & Island Touring

With a local guide leading the way, explore the landscapes, stories and welcoming communities of Prince Edward Island along with the historic streets of Charlottetown.

No visit to PEI would be complete without stepping into the beloved world of Lucy Maud Montgomery at **Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place**. This evening, gather in New Glasgow for a **traditional PEI lobster dinner**. Non-seafood alternatives are available.

Day 10 - Charlottetown to Saint John, NB

Say goodbye to PEI as you cross the impressive 13-km **Confederation Bridge** into New Brunswick. At **Hopewell Rocks**, experience the dramatic landscape shaped by the Bay of Fundy's extraordinary tides before continuing to Saint John for a three-night stay.

Day 11 - St. Andrews By-The-Sea

Travel to picturesque **St. Andrews by-the-Sea** for the day, known for beautiful architecture, coastal scenery and abundant marine life. Set sail on the **Jolly Breeze Tall Ship** for an exciting whale-watching adventure on the Bay of Fundy. Later, when the tide allows, drive across the sea floor to

Ministers Island and enjoy a guided tour of the historic Van Horne Estate

Day 12 - Saint John

Discover Canada's oldest incorporated city on a morning **tour of Saint John**, then visit the remarkable **Reversing Falls**. If the tides align, watch as the powerful Bay of Fundy meets the Saint John River and appears to reverse its flow.
