**Day 11 – Frankenmuth.**

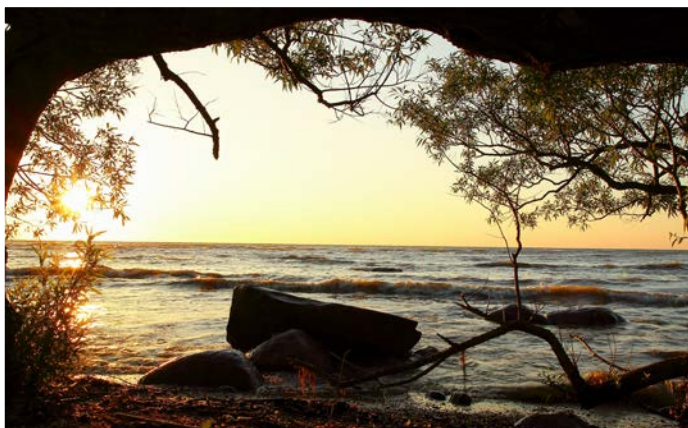
A visit to the **Henry Ford Museum** is planned for this morning. Enjoy a tour of the museum & factory. Start your Christmas shopping early, we'll stop at

Once we arrive in Grand Rapids, we'll visit the **Judy Garland Museum**, home of the world's largest Judy Garland and Wizard of Oz collection.

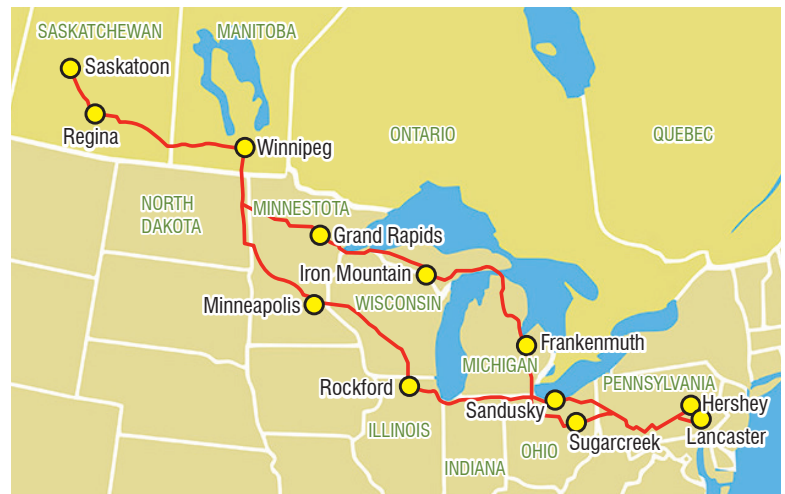
